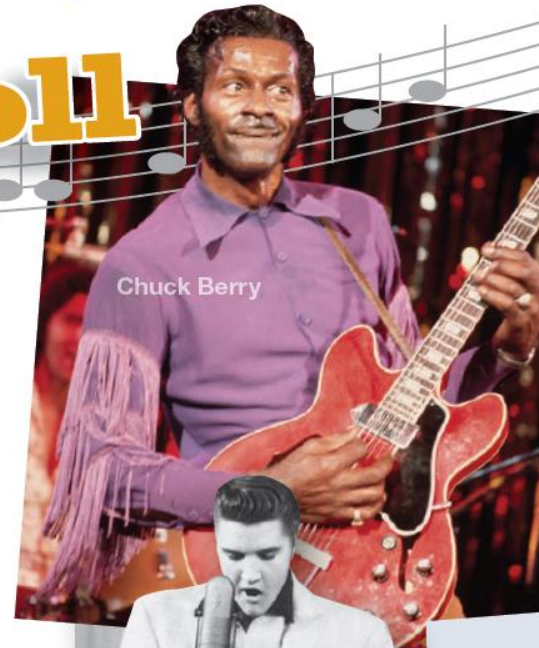
Rock 'n' Roll

Rock and roll became popular with young people in the United States in the early 1950s. At that time, many parents criticized the new music style. They said it was a passing craze and that it wouldn't last long. But rock and roll spread all over the world, and is still popular everywhere.

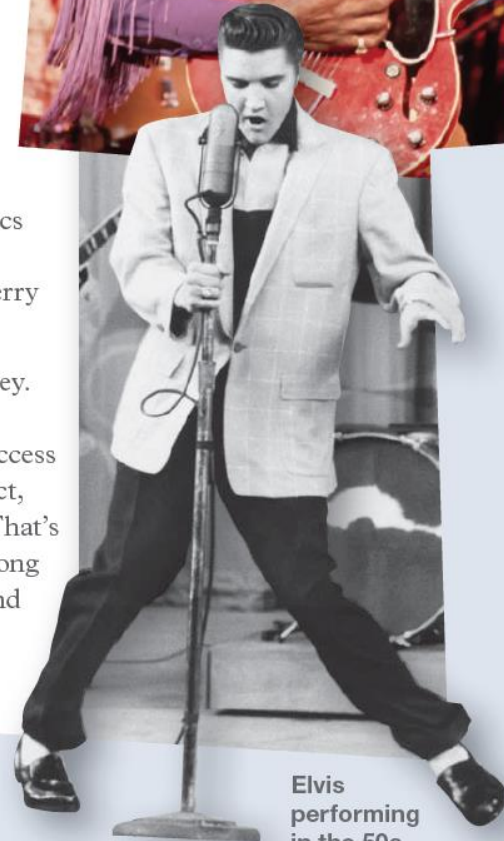
Rock developed from a variety of popular music styles: blues, rhythm and blues, jazz, gospel, and American country music. The electric guitar, the saxophone of jazz bands, and the melodies and harmonies of popular music contributed to the rock sound. Originally, rock attracted fans of both rhythm and blues and country music.

Chuck Berry was the first of the great rock songwriters. His lyrics expressed the feelings and problems of youth. Berry's first hit record was a country-styled tune titled "Maybelline" (1955). Berry was a major influence on later rock performers.

However, the real rock and roll explosion began with Elvis Presley. The new sound of his music combined with his hip-shaking performances quickly made Elvis a superstar. His first major success came with his 1956 recording of "Heartbreak Hotel." But, in fact, the song that is considered the first true rock and roll song is "That's All Right." Radio stations in Memphis, Tennessee, played the song over and over. Listeners wanted to know who the singer was. And the Elvis legend began.

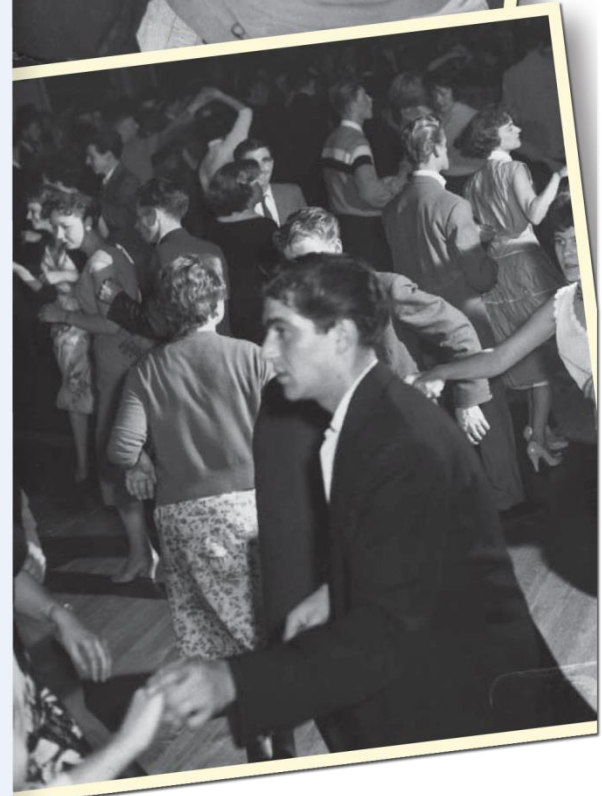
*Go, go, go Johnny go

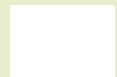
